The Michigan Department of Agriculture requires schools to notify parents when pesticides, herbicides, insecticides, etc. are being applied on school grounds. The Oxford School District normally applies these chemicals during the summer vacation and other vacation periods when school is not in session. Occasionally, in emergencies, we may be required to apply these chemicals when school is in session.

You have the right to be informed prior to any pesticide application made on the school grounds and buildings. In certain emergencies, pesticides may be applied without prior notice, but you will be provided notice following any such application. If you want prior notification, please complete the information below and submit to your **Building Principal**. If you **do not want** prior notification you need **not return the form**.
