The Michigan Department of Environmental Quality requires an annual inspection of your arsenic removal treatment system. An inspection was conducted by a representative of the Oakland County Health Division (OCHD) on November 16, 2021. The system appears to be in working order and monthly operation reports (MORs) are being submitted.

Remember, treated arsenic sample results are required to be submitted to OCHD each calendar quarter. The next treated arsenic sample result must be submitted prior to December 31, 2021. Submit MORs by the 15th day of the following month.
