




Based on the information provided in our initial plan, what is your current plan for educating your child(ren) for the 2020-2021 school year?








In the fall, do you plan to use bus service?




Do you plan to send your child to school with a prepared lunch most or all days?






Have you or do you plan to register your child(ren) for before school or after school Child Care (Extended Day) through OELC if school resumes in person instruction in the fall?






Does your household have reliable internet service?






Does your child have a cloth/reusable face mask?




